JET Grant Program
FY 2010 Allocation to Public Junior Colleges and Public Technical Institutes**



In Fiscal Year 2010, the Comptroller will allocate \$2.5 million to public junior colleges or public technical institutes for scholarships for distribution to students enrolled in a training program for high-demand occupations, as determined by the Comptroller. Scholarships may only be awarded to students seeking professional registration, certification or licensure in a high-demand occupation, where a certificate or an associate degree is the basic prerequisite for such registration, certification or licensure.

Each public junior college or public technical institute will receive an allocation based upon the following formula. Institutions are allowed to re-allocate up to 10 percent of the grant amount for the certificate or associate degree program allocations as long as it does not exceed the total allocation.
